Arrival in Manila

Manila City Tour

The tour continues with a visit to **San Agustin Church**, the oldest stone church in the city which has a museum of religious and secular art. In addition, we will also visit Barrio San Luis which is a complex of reconstructed housing from the 19th century.




Pagsanjan Falls trip

- ✓ On this day, after breakfast pick up at the hotel and drive on the way to Laguna.
- ✓ We will be driving around 3 hours to the Town of Pagsanjan located in Laguna.
- ✓ Along the way we shall view the Beauty of vast rice field, the Filipino local community and lifestyle, some historical places and attraction. And while on the way to Pagsanjan falls we shall stop over just for the toilet if needed.


Arrival in Pagsanjan Falls:

- ✓ We will take a small boat shooting the Rapids boats (Banca) more or less 1 hour and 45 minutes to the main “**Most Famous Waterfalls in the Philippines**”.
- ✓ Enjoy this exciting ride as the boat is skillfully maneuverer upstream by two expert boatmen.
- ✓ While we were heading to the main taller falls, we shall stop by to the first falls, “Talahib Falls” for some great viewing and picture taking for about 10 minutes, and then proceed to the biggest waterfalls of the Philippines where you can see and enjoy.
- ✓ After spending some time at the falls, return downstream by ‘shooting the rapids’ – your boatmen will steer past huge boulders in churning waters at top speeds for a fun, exhilarating ride!
- ✓ Please make sure to bring extra clothes since you will be wet and covers for your camera, wallet and cell phone.
- ✓ Wear light dress.
- ✓ After 2 hours of boating adventure, back to the Restaurant.
- ✓ Change your wet clothes in the shower Room, and then proceed to buffet Lunch.
- ✓ Have a short tour in the old city (if time permits)
- ✓ Stay overnight at **1898 Hotel**.
- ✓ Rest and leisure



Located in Laguna, **Pagsanjan Falls** is one of the most visited tourist spot south of Manila and is the place where the movie “Apocalypse Now” with Marlon Brando was shot. Vast rice fields and coconut plantation can be seen along the way from the riverside resort.

Pagsanjan Falls (indigenous name: Magdapio Falls) is one of the most famous waterfalls in the Philippines. Located in the province of Laguna, the falls is one of the major tourist attractions in the region. The falls are reached by a river trip on dugout canoe, known locally as “Shooting the rapids”, originating from the municipality of Pagsanjan. The boat ride has been an attraction since the Spanish Colonial Era with the oldest written account in 1894. The town of Pagsanjan lies at the confluence of two rivers, the Balanac River and the Bumbungan River (also known as the Pagsanjan River).



Hidden Valley Spring

- ✓ After breakfast at the hotel pick up then proceed to Hidden Valley Spring
- ✓ Pick up time at 8:30 AM
- ✓ Travel time approximately 3 hour's drive
- ✓ We shall stop on the way for some refreshment and toilet if needed.
- ✓ Upon reaching Hidden Valley, you can start your day by swimming in the clear natural water. There are six natural pools which you can enjoy.
- ✓ Aside from swimming, another activity is hiking /strolling in the surrounding rainforest. Be one with nature and savor its peace and serenity: Follow the path to scattered springs and the "hidden waterfall" through wooden bridge ways and stoned pathways.
- ✓ After swimming and strolling, we shall leave the resort then proceed for lunch.
- ✓ After lunch drive back to Manila.
- ✓ Overnight stay at **1898 Hotel**
- ✓ Rest and Leisure



An excellent day trip destination located just 2 hours' drive south of Manila. The hot springs of the hidden valley provide an excellent getaway from the hustle and bustle of the city. The Valley is believed to be formed by a volcanic eruption thousands of years ago. Aside of the hot and cold swimming pools, the area is surrounded by massive vegetation and some rare orchids.

Hidden Valley Springs, located between Mt. Makiling and Mt. Banahaw, it is hidden in the middle of superb forest. A track goes into the jungle and, in half an hour, leads right up to the water falls crashing onto the mossy rocks below. There are at least six swimming pools naturally heated by volcanic waters.

Puning Hot Spring

- ✓ After breakfast pick you up at the hotel
- ✓ Drive on the way to Angeles, Pampanga. Travel time approximately 2 to 3 hours.
- ✓ Upon arrival in Angeles, you will proceed to Sta. Juliana, the jump-off point for everyone going to Mt. Pinatubo. After the briefing about the trip and a reminder of safety precautions, you will board a 4x4, the only transportation to get to Puning Hot Spring.
- ✓ The drive to the hot springs is an exciting journey in itself: a thrilling and bumpy experience that will reward you with **spectacular views** of what's left behind by **Mt. Pinatubo's** catastrophic eruption. Stunning rock formations, eruption debris, and canyons formed from mudflows are some of the things you will see along the way.
- ✓ After the ride through Pinatubo's rugged landscape, you will reach Puning's Hot Spring Resort and Sand Spa built right on the lahar that formed along the foothills of the volcano. Stone steps lead to numerous pools of spring water heated naturally by the molten rocks of Mt. Pinatubo. Enjoy the therapeutic effects of soaking your body in the warm waters and feel your body aches fade away.
- ✓ Once you're done in the pool, try the volcanic sand spa. Covering your body with warm sand alleviates muscle pain while the mudpack exfoliates your skin and gives it a healthy glow. Afterwards, you will hop back on the 4x4 to go back to the station where your van will pick you up and bring you back to your hotel in Manila.
- ✓ Stay overnight at **1898 Hotel**.



At the foot of one of the most destructive volcanoes of the 21st century lies **Puning Hot Spring** and Sand Spa, a lone resort that reflects the warmth of the thriving Aeta tribe.

This spot is only 10 minutes from Sapang Bato gate, which is located in Sitio Target, neighboring Mabalacat City. The attraction's name derives its roots from the word punang, which in the Aeta language means "full of trees". Despite the cataclysmic volcanic eruption in 1991, one can still find vibrancy and life teeming in the midst of a desolate wasteland.



Manila to Puerto Prinsesa, Palawan

- ✓ After breakfast transfer to the airport for your flight to Puerto Prinsesa.
- ✓ Upon arrival at PPS airport transfer to **Sheridan Beach Resort and Spa** for your overnight stay.



Captivating Underground River

- ✓ On this day, you will visit the underground river who lately won as one of the new seventh wonders of the world.
- ✓ Explore the Puerto Princesa Underground River National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- ✓ See one of the "**New 7th Wonders of the World**", the longest navigable subterranean river.
- ✓ You'll drive to Sabang Wharf before transferring by boat to the Underground River National Park. This location is not merely the access to the river: it's also a national park that is a haven for local and some endemic wildlife in the Philippines, and famous as a birdwatching site. The highlight of the tour remains as the guided paddle boat which will take you across the underground river.
- ✓ For around 45 minutes, you'll be able to explore this deep, cavernous river, and see the rock formations that have captured the imagination of the world. Listen to your audio commentary or get insider knowledge from your boatman guide as he points out numerous fascinating features within the cave by torchlight. From stalagmites and stalactites shaped as vegetables, dinosaurs, Jesus and more, to the thousands of swallows and bats that swoop about the tunnels, you're sure to be in awe throughout the trip.

The **Puerto Princesa Subterranean River National Park** is a protected area of the Philippines. The park is located in the Saint Paul Mountain Range on the western coast of the island of Palawan, about 80 kilometres north of the city center of Puerto Princesa, and contains the Puerto Princesa Subterranean River.



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Mangrove Tour

Expect an encounter with the wildlife that thrive in this area as well, which include several species of snakes, monitor lizards, kingfishers, monkeys, and wild chickens.

Policy Payment and Cancellation

To confirm your reservation, the 40% of the final amount of the trip must be paid. The rest of the balance must be paid 30 days before the start of the trip.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

However, if you do need to cancel, then all our local travel agents apply the same policy.

The breakdown is as follows:

- up to 30 days before the trip start date, a cancellation fee equal to the previously agreed down payment or equal to 20% applies;
- from 15 to 29 days before the trip start date, 30% of the total price of the trip is non-refundable;
- from 7 to 14 days before the trip start date, 60% of the total price of the trip is non-refundable;
- and 6 days or less before the trip start date, 90% of the total price of the trip is non-refundable;

Once the domestic flight tickets have been issued, no refund will be possible. It will be notified when it is issued. The possible financial expenses derived from the bank transfer will be borne by the client when it is refunded.

Cancellations due to weather conditions, natural disasters and political or security-related situations

Travelers will be able to reschedule their trip with us if canceled due to adverse situations such as those described in the title. Even travelers can give their bookings to other people. This must be confirmed by email, providing valid government identification of the person who would take your position. Any surcharge applied by the airline or lodging for this matter will be covered by

If there are surcharges (additional nights in accommodation, etc.) caused by delayed flights or other changes in the itinerary caused by weather conditions, the additional costs will have to be covered by travelers irrespective of whether these amounts are later claimed to the traveler insurance.
